Take the A12 to Ipswich A12/A14 roundabout. Turn right onto the A14 towards Felixstowe. Take the first exit after the Orwell Bridge sign-posted Nacton and Ransomes Europark. Follow signs for the A1156 and Suffolk Showground.

### **From the North - Great Yarmouth**

Take the A12 until the junction with the A14. At the A12/A14 roundabout, follow signs for Ipswich East, A1156 and Suffolk Showground.
